To open a new user account, you first need an activation letter with your personal activa-

tion code. If you do not have an activation letter, please call us (+41 56 203 44 22) or send an email message to kundendienst@aquilana.ch. Registration is then easy. Just download the myAquilana app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store or set up your myAquilana user account easily and conveniently via the customer portal access with the QR code or directly at www.myaquilana.ch.

Registration steps

- Download the app or go to www.myaquilana.ch/auth/self-registration.
 Enter the code taken from your activation letter and the insurance number shown on your insurance policy.
- 2 Read and accept the terms and conditions of use.
- ³Specify your **user name** by entering your **email address** and then enter the code received by email for **security purposes**.
- 4 Enter your mobile phone number to receive an SMS code in the future for signing in to myAquilana. Check your mobile number with the SMS code received by you.
- 5 Finally, set up a **password** to **log on** to your myAquilana account.
- Restrictions on registration apply to persons who are subject to an advance directive/ care order and for persons under the age of 14.
- Only insured persons who are domiciled in Switzerland can register.
- The app can only be downloaded in Switzerland.
- Your data are stored in Switzerland and nowhere else.
- No more paper copies of the most frequent documents

(bills for services, premium accounts, policies and tax certificates)
